

## **T.O. firm promises you a dream fleet**

A Toronto-based company called **DreamFleet Inc.** has introduced what amounts to an automobile time-sharing club.

Members have a choice of several options for changing vehicles within a prescribed lease period, not unlike the AutoShare network but for people with more limited budgets.

Does a summer convertible and winter sport utility vehicle best suit your needs?

No problem.

Want to spend a few months in some of the hot sports sedans on the market?

You can do it.

Prefer a sampling of roadsters? You can do that, too.

As a member, you can virtually create your own dream fleet, on your own schedule.

Describing itself as an "automobile lifestyle club," DreamFleet, on its website, says it offers "four flexible, convenient programs to suit your personal driving patterns."

It promises "no penalties, no depreciation shock, no compromises."

To drive three different cars over three years will typically cost you about \$90 a month more than leasing one for three years, according to Edmond Helstab, the company's founder and president.

Not surprisingly, most members to date are interested in cars that sell in the \$60,000 to \$120,000 range, he says.

When it comes time to move on to the next selection, they do so at an upscale club event.

To qualify for membership, among other things, you must be at least 25 and meet minimum standards for creditworthiness and driving record.
